Apocalypse

 Notice that the Book of Revelation is at the end of the Bible. It barely made it into the scriptures. It's one of the two or three biblical books that calls itself a vision, a dream, yet it's a book that many people seem to take more literally than they do the non-dream books. Try interpreting your dreams and you'll see why people expound weird ideas based on this book.

Prophecy

 Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of the prophecy, and blessed are those who hear and who keep what is written in it; for the time is near.

Text

 ¹¹ The apocalypse of Jesus Christ which God gave him to show his servants what must soon become reality; and he revealed this through the angel he sent to his servant John, ² who bore witness to the word of God and who bore witness to Jesus Christ, as much as he saw. ³ Blessed is the one reading, and the ones hearing, the words of the prophecy, and the ones keeping what has been written in it, for the time is near.

Seven

- Favorite number of the Apocalypse
- In the Old Testament denotes "fullness," that is the time for something to be done effectively, or a general designation of completeness or fulness.
- Sometimes the number seven is both literal and figurative.
